Chemical analysis of thirtyone tubes of various makes shows the contents to consist of approximately 60 per cent common baking soda, 26 per cent fine sand, 8 per cent pulverized chalk and 4 per cent coloured matter, chiefly iron oxide. The inefficiency of dry powder extinguishers was made the subject of searching investigation by a special committee appointed by the British Home Office in March, 1916. 


