A Pacific Assurance. Victoria, B.C., June 28.—Senator Voorhes, of Indiana, arrived here yesterday on route to Alaska. He said that it was a mistake when the American Government would close Behring Sea to foreign vessels. The whole trouble in his opinion was engendered by the Alaska Commercial Company, and the President of that company was aware of this fact. A commission would be appointed to inquire into the Fisheries question. Senator Voorhes thought the question would form an issue in the next Presidential campaign.
