The County Court Judges in the various counties have been appointed registrars for their respective districts, and will kold revision courts from October 31 to November 5, both inclusive On any of these dates the legally qualified who are not now enrolled as voters will be able to have their names added to the lists of the district in which they reside. This re vision announcement will make it possible for all who have come of age since the 1919 revision was made to secure the franchise and will also open the way for hun dreds perhaps thousands of women who failed to realize the necessity of registering when the call went out some months ago.. A Montreal Star writer, who has been studying the method to be pursued, declares that for each 4,000 of population in every constituency one registrar will be appointed. These will take as the nucleus of their lists the latest available municipal list of el ectors. Four days before commencing the revision notices will appear broadcast announcing the fact, and when registration commences bur caus will remain open from nine Election Act. The qualification, broadly speaking, for both men and women is British citizenship, the legal age of twenty-one years, a year's residence in Canada and at least two months' residence in the district for which registration is desired. British citizenship, of course, includes those born in Canada or elsewhere in the King's dominions or on a British ship, or who was born elsewhere of a father who was a British subject by birth or naturalization. 
