



## **SEED TIME AND** THE OAT SUPPLY

The unfortunate crop condition in especially for oats, led the Seed Pur chasing Commission of the Seed Branch at Ottawa to hold in reservconsiderably more than half a million bushels of No. 1 seed oats for this spring's seeding. This grain was stored a government interior terminal elevators at Calgary and Saskatoon Early in March about 400,000 bushels of this grain had been disposed of. a considerable proportion of it going to Ontario, Quebec, and more eastern points. The Seed Purchasing Commission supplies seed cats in car loads only and at the net wost of the re-cleaned seed. It is under stood that during recent months bankers and others have persisted in encouraging merchants to be caution Reports reaching the Seed Commis sioner indicate that seed merchants have been so guided by these pre insufficient supply of seed grain to meet the full requirements. So much of the success of a crop depends on the quality of the seed sown it into the ground when the proper seeding time arrives, that farmers who have not already secured their full requirements of seed should see to it without further delay.




