

TRANSATLANTIC ADVICES.

ARRIVAL OF QUEEN VICTORIA AT DARMSTADT.

President Carnot's Tour.—The Skuptschina's Military Grab.—Bank This Week.—The French Loss in Dahomey.—Honors to Stanley at Brussels.

BERLIN, April 23.—Queen Victoria arrived at Darmstadt to-day. She was received at the railway station by the municipal authorities and other prominent officials. A guard of honor was also present and saluted Her Majesty.

Carnot's Tour. PARIS, April 23.—The train on which President Carnot was traveling from Ajaccio, Corsica, was prevented from reaching Bastia on time by the derailment of the train preceding it.

Scrapped by the Skuptschina. BELGRADE, April 23.—The Skuptschina passed a bill introduced by the Government retaining for military purposes one-twentieth of all the moneys received by direct taxation until \$200,000 for accumulated. It has also voted \$100,000 for establishing a new powder factory.

Bank Suffers Fulfilled. LONDON, April 23.—Three Americans, giving their names as Frank Lacroze, William Smith and Charles Robinson, were convicted of attempting to rob Bank Clerk Stone of a bag containing \$3000 worth of checks, notes and gold, and sentenced to 17 months' imprisonment.

The French Reverse in Dahomey. PARIS, April 23.—Official despatches confirm the report of a French reverse in Dahomey. One white man was killed and 30 native allies were wounded.

The Antipodean Floods. SYDNEY, N.S.W., April 23.—The flood caused by the overflow of the Darling River is subsiding. A fund has been opened for the benefit of the sufferers by the flood.

The Miners' Demands. PARIS, April 23.—The St. Etienne Miners' Congress has resolved to demand a working day of eight hours and uniform wages in all collieries and if these demands were not complied with to strike on May Day.

The Irish Porters' Strike. COBK, April 23.—The railway porters' strike is spreading to other towns. The situation is serious.

Whipped by Whitecaps. ST. LOUIS, April 23.—Advisors from the Chicagoan Nation say a large band of Whitecaps raided a wide section of the southern part of the reservation last night, whipped a number of men and gave them notice to quit the Nation in five days. A number of other persons who were not whipped were notified to leave in ten days.

Never Too Late to Wed. MAY'S LANDING, April 23.—Robert Barnes, aged 76 years, was married to-day to Mrs. Sallie Smith, aged 32 years, of Atlantic City. Many relatives and friends were present and the happy couple tripped the light fantastic to old-time music.

Killed by a Train. PICKERSWILL, April 23.—Mrs. John Ludgate, a woman about 60 years old, was killed instantly by a Grand Trunk train this afternoon while walking on the track just east of the station. She leaves a husband and two daughters.

A Texas Cyclone. AUSTIN, Tex., April 23.—The little town of Kyle, 30 miles south of here, was visited by a cyclone last night and many houses were overturned and several swept away. Several persons were injured but none killed.

Another C.P.R. Survey. WINDSOR, April 23.—Another Canadian Pacific Railroad surveying staff is in town. It is reported that they will survey a road to Amherstburg from a point on the Canadian Pacific Railway close to Windsor.
