- 1st - We use only the best quality of Galvanized-Atteled Steel Wire.
2d - The two strands of No. 14 Wire are twisted together just enough to allow for the contraction and expansion of the metal caused by heat and cold, and not so much as to impair the structure of the wire.
3d - The Barbs on one Wire are four-pointed, thus always presenting a sharp lateral or at a right angle, which is a great advantage over the Two-Point Barbs, as cattle are unable to get around the fence to break it or push it down.
4th - The Barbs are fastened to the Wire at intervals of 12 inches, thus presenting a sharp point to the eye, and being securely locked around and across both wires, so that they cannot slip or more toward each other, and they also prevent the untwisting of the cables should either wire get broken.
5th - The machinery by which the Barbs are put on is so perfect that the cable wires are not injured or weakened by the process, as is the case with other Four-Pointed Barb Wires.
