Rev. H. Wendt in the *Philatelic West's* leading article for June-July gives a little history of the Schleswig-Holstein stamps. The statistics as given show that about 9000 stamped letters passed through the post office from Nov. 15th, 1850 until the little dukedom of Schleswig was again attached to Denmark—Feb. 1st., 1851. The stamps already in the hands of the people continued to circulate until September when all remainders were kept secure at Copenhagen until 1864. It is supposed that at this time these were sold to stamp dealers, as unused specimens from that date have been moderate in price.—U.S.O.

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
