Mary＇s was the joys of Bethlehem． Let women carry the Saviour＇s tid－ ings afar．

The Rev．J．Wilkinson，speaking of the claims of the mission to the Jews，stated that as the result of earnest mission efforts both in Eng－ land and on the continent there are now between 30,000 and 40,000 Christian Jews accepting the Lord Jesus as their Messiah．There are amongst them 401 ministers and mis－ sionaries，and of these 100 are cler－ gyman of the Church of England． It was well known that half a cen－ tury ago a Jew would only blaspheme if he heard the name of Christ，but now by hundreds there are jews preaching the gospel and even some of the rabbis speaking of Him in their writings in terms of high praise as the greatest reformer that ever lived．
