Excellencies,

I have the honour to refer to the discussions which have taken place between representatives of the Governments of the Federal Republic of Germany, the Kingdom of Belgium, Canada, the French Republic, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America concerning the Agreement of 19 June 1951<sup>(1)</sup> between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty regarding the Status of their Forces, the Agreement of 3 August 1959<sup>(2)</sup> to supplement that Agreement with respect to foreign forces stationed in the Federal Republic of Germany ("the Supplementary Agreement"), and the Agreements related thereto. I have the honour to propose on behalf of the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany that your Governments note that:

1. Following the establishment of German unity and the conclusion of the Treaty on the Final Settlement with respect to Germany, signed on 12 September 1990, the above-mentioned Agreements remain in force, subject to paragraphs 2 and 4 below.
