GENERAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF BOLIVIA CONCERNING DEVELOPMENT CO-OPERATION

The Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Bolivia (hereinafter called "the Government of Bolivia"), wishing to strengthen the existing cordial relations between the two countries and their peoples and moved by the desire to develop a program of co-operation between the two countries in conformity with the objectives of economic and social development of the Government of Bolivia, have agreed to the following:

ARTICLE I

The program of development co-operation shall provide for:

- 1. the granting of scholarships to citizens of Bolivia for studies and professional training in Canada, Bolivia or a third country;
- 2. the assignment of Canadian experts, advisers and other specialists to Bolivia;
- 3. the provision of equipment, materials and other goods required for the execution of co-operation projects in Bolivia;
- 4. the elaboration of studies and projects designed to contribute to the economic and social development of Bolivia; and
- 5. any other form of assistance which may be mutually agreed upon.

ARTICLE II

- 1. To reach the objectives of this Agreement, the Government of Canada and the Government of Bolivia may conclude subsidiary arrangements or loan agreements in respect of specific projects involving one or several components of the program described in Article I.
- 2. Unless expressly stated otherwise, subsidiary arrangements concerning grants or contributions from the Government of Canada shall be considered as administrative arrangements.
- 3. Loan agreements shall be the subject of formal agreements between the Contracting Parties and shall bind them under international law.
