Mr. Secretary,

I have the honour to refer to the discussions which took place recently between officials of The St. Lawrence Seaway Authority of Canada and the Saint Lawrence Seaway Development Corporation of the United States regarding the Memorandum of Agreement between those agencies, dated January 29, 1959, and the Tariff of Tolls set out therein, which were attached to the Exchange of Notes of March 9, 1959<sup>(1)</sup>, between our two Governments, and amended in 1964<sup>(2)</sup>, 1967<sup>(3)</sup>, 1972<sup>(4)</sup>, 1978<sup>(5)</sup>, 1980<sup>(6)</sup>, 1982<sup>(7)</sup>, 1984<sup>(8)</sup>, 1985<sup>(9)</sup>, 1986<sup>(10)</sup>, 1987<sup>(11)</sup>, 1988<sup>(12)</sup>, 1989<sup>(13)</sup>, 1991<sup>(14)</sup>, 1992<sup>(15)</sup> and 1993<sup>(16)</sup>.

The discussions resulted in the signature of the enclosed Memorandum of Agreement by the President of The St. Lawrence Seaway Authority at Ottawa on April 11, 1994 and by the Administrator of the Saint Lawrence Seaway Development Corporation at Washington, D.C. on April 21, 1994. This Memorandum of Agreement sets forth amendments to the Memorandum
