SOMMAIRE

By an exchange of letters dated April 22 and April 29, 1948, our Government and the United States Government agreed to extend the duration of 1948 an agreement first entered into in 1942 for the exchange of agricultural labour and machinery between Canada and the United States of America for the period of one year, and that the details of the movement of farm labour and machinery mentioned above be arranged between the Canadian and United States officials directly concerned.
