THE DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE AUSTRALIAN MINISTER FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE R.G. CASEY, WILL ARRIVE IN OTTAWA ON SUNDAY MORNING, NOVEMBER 4, FROM LONDON, AND WILL BE IN OTTAWA UNTIL WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON, NOVEMBER 7. ACCOMPANYING HIM WILL BE MRS. CASEY, MR. BRIAN HILL OF THE AUSTRALIAN MISSION TO THE UNITED NATIONS IN NEW YORK, AND MR. RICHARD GARDNER, HIS PRIVATE SECRETARY, ALL OF WHOM WILL BE GUESTS AT GOVERNMENT HOUSE.

DURING THE VISIT, MR. AND MRS. CASEY WILL BE ENTERTAINED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS AND MRS. PEARSON AND BY THE ACTING HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR AUSTRALIA AND MRS. T.A. PYMAN. MR. CASEY WILL HOLD A PRESS CONFERENCE IN THE MAIN CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE EAST BLOCK AT 11 A.M. ON MONDAY, NOVEMBER 5, AND WILL CALL ON THE PRIME MINISTER OF CANADA AT 12:30 P.M. THE SAME DAY. HE WILL CALL ON MR. PEARSON ON TUESDAY MORNING. MRS. CASEY WILL MEET WITH MEMBERS OF THE PRESS AT 10:45 A.M. TUESDAY MORNING AT THE RESIDENCE, 407 WILBROD STREET.
