

Although the execution of projects financed through the bilateral programme is subject to the signature of a Memorandum of Agreement between the governments of Canada and Haïti, the projects themselves are without exception implemented via a Canadian organization which has the responsibility for attaining the objectives of the projects, and managing the human, material and financial resources devoted to its realization.

During 1984-85 approximately 42% of the total Canadian aid budget to Haïti has been allocated to projects undertaken by the non-governmental sector. This is in recognition of their success in organizing and delivering essential services, particularly to the most disadvantaged sectors of the Haïtian population.
