PRAYERS.

Three Petitions were laid on the Table.

Mr. Gordon, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,
—Copies of Orders in Council passed under the provisions of the Unemployment and Farm Relief Continuance Act, 1932, as follows:—

Order in Council, P.C. 2493, dated 14th November, 1932: authorizing payment to the Province of Nova Scotia of \$3,862.79 for direct relief.

Order in Council, P.C. 2494, dated 14th November, 1932: authorizing payment to the Province of New Brunswick of \$42.67 for direct relief distributed in the County of Restigouche.

Order in Council, P.C. 2495, dated 14th November, 1932: authorizing payment to the Province of Saskatchewan of \$1,527.41 for direct relief distributed in unorganized districts and for placement of men on farms.

Order in Council, P.C. 2496, dated 14th November, 1932: authorizing payment to the Province of Alberta of \$3,603.53 for direct relief.

—Copy of the Report of the Re-organization Commission for Pigs and Pig Products published by the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries of Great Britain.

Mr. Bennett, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House,
—Copy of Order in Council, P.C. 2077, dated 20th September, 1932, guaranteeing to the chartered banks, payment by each of the following agencies: Manitoba Wheat Pool, Saskatchewan Co-operative Wheat Producers, Limited, and Alberta Wheat Pool, of the advances made, or to be made, by any chartered bank to any of these Agencies in connection with the marketing of wheat and other grains grown in the western provinces in 1932.
