DEPARTMENTAL ADVERTISING EXPENDITURES

Question No. 1,745—**Mr. Stevens:**

For the current fiscal year, what are the estimated expenditures of the Department of Communications for (a) advertising (b) free or subsidized publications (c) other information conveyed to the public?

Mr. Peter Stollery (Parliamentary Secretary to Secretary of State and Minister of Communications): In so far as the Department of Communications is concerned, the answer to the above question is as follows: for fiscal year 1980-81 projected expenditures

- (a) None;
- (b) \$415,000;
- (c) \$198,000.

Question No. 1,752—**Mr. Stevens:**

For the current fiscal year, what are the estimated expenditures of the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development for (a) advertising (b) free or subsidized publications (c) other information conveyed to the public?

Hon. John C. Munro (Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development): In so far as the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development is concerned, the answer is: the department is projecting an expenditure of \$1,253,000 in the current fiscal year, 1980-81, for (a) media advertising, (b) free or subsidized publications, and (c) other information. It is not possible to break down the expenditure into the various subdivisions as in (a), (b) and (c).
