of Old St. Andrew's Church, Toronto, who also gave his lecture, "Is Life Worth Living?" on Monday evening. At this service Mr. Lawrie gave a brief historic statement of Knox Church, and Dr. Smith gave a report of the Century Fund canvass, stating that the amount subscribed to date is \$5,728.

In a memento as brief as this must necessarily be, we regret that no attempt can be made to do anything like justice to the generosity and self-denying effort that even a brief ten years of Church work must have meant to many. The best results cannot always be recorded in figures, and many of the most wonderful chapters of Church History will never be written. Nor will space here permit even the naming of those who have served so faithfully in the societies and committees of the individual Church; nevertheless their rewards await them.

With such a record of sixty years witnessing for Christ, let us look forward with fidelity to the God of our fathers, to a still more useful future for Knox Church in the service of the King.
