his only surviving brother, Alexander Wellesley Macnab, to Belleville, and there interred in the old family burial ground, by the side of his father's father—the Venerable Archdeacon Patton performing the funeral service.

On Sunday, August 18th, the Reverend J. GAMBLE GEDDES, Rector of Christ Church, Hamilton, preached on occasion of his death, from St. James iv. 14:—"For what is your life? It is even a vapour that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away." In this there is the following allusion to the recent death of his lamented Curate:—

"I have been preaching to you, my brethren, of the shortness and uncertainty of life; but the events of the past week have surely impressed these solemn truths more deeply on your hearts. The details of that melancholy occurrence I could not bring myself to recount to you from this place; but, knowing how anxious one and all would be to be informed, I caused them to be made known to you through the local press. You have no doubt wept over that sad recital. You pictured to yourselves the earnest, single minded, guileless and devoted young minister of Christ; full of zeal and full of promise. You remember his earnest appeals to you in the cause of his heavenly Master, from this very pulpit, now draped in mourning for his
