

New Road on the West Side of Canal, between lots 28 and 29 in the 3rd and 4th Concessions and on the Back Ditch of the Canal, from the 5th Concession Line to the Feeder Bridge in the Township of Humberstone.

1st. That said road was commenced and laid out by Mr. DeCew, in the Fall of 1874.

2nd. That on the 4th day of June, 1874, the County Council then in session did adopt a report of a Special Committee upon the petition of E. W. Fares and others, wherein was recommended that the County of Welland should grant the sum of \$1600 towards the construction of said road, providing the Township of Humberstone would appropriate \$1,000 and insure from other sources the sum of \$742, making in all \$3,342, being about the amount estimated by the Engineer, Samuel D. Woodruff, for the Road to cost, as shown by his report attached to the said Petition.

3rd. That the sum of \$1,720.59 has been expended by the Township of Humberstone upon said road in the following manner, viz.:

Paid Mr. DeCew, for surveying the road and laying out ditches....	\$ 38 00

4th. The County has paid upon the grant aforesaid to the present time, the sum of \$1400 which has been expended as follows, viz.:

For quarrying stone in Winter 1874-75.....	\$ 528 22
For drawing stone in Winter of 1874-75.....	407 52
For breaking stone in Winter of 1874-75.....	64 26
For quarrying stone and loading in Summer of 1879.....	189 00
For framing stone and loading in Summer of 1879.....	145 00
For breaking stone and loading in Summer of 1879.....	66 00
Total grant expended.....	\$1400 00
