SECTION 2. The Board of Trustees shall annually appoint a Committee on *Resources*, whose duty it shall be to use any means. not derogatory to the honor of the Association, to obtain contributions to the funds of the Association, independent of the annual payments of the members.

SECTION 3. The Trustees may by vote, in which two-thirds of the Board concur, expel any member from the Board, and in case of any such expulsion from or any vacancy in the Board, shall report to the Association, at the first meeting after such vacancy occurs, the circumstances connected with such vacancy or expulsion, and it shall then be the duty of the members of said Association to elect a trustee from their number to fill such vacancy.

SECTION 4. Duties of President. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at the meetings of the Association and of the Board of Trustees, and to keep order therein in accordance with the principles and rules of Parliamentary law; to call meetings of the Board of Trustees or Association whenever he may deem necessary. He shall, at the written request of three members of the Board of Trustees, call Special Meetings of the Board of Trustees. He shall also call Special Meetings of the Association whenever any ten members of the Association shall request him in writing to do so, and it shall be his duty to order the Secretary to notify, in writing or printing, the Board of Trustees or the members of the Association, of any such meetings.
