

CONSTITUTION.

I.—NAME AND OBJECT.

This Society shall be called the "MONTREAL PARLIAMENTARY DEBATING SOCIETY," and its object shall be the promotion of the art of public speaking.

II.—MEMBERSHIP.

Membership shall be open to all on payment of an annual subscription of one dollar, and a member shall be entitled to take his seat in the House after being proposed and seconded. (The payment of two dollars shall entitle to honorary membership).

III.—OFFICERS.

The Officers of the Society shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Speaker, Deputy-Speaker, Clerk of the House and Sergeant-at-Arms, who shall be elected at every annual general meeting to serve for one year, but shall be eligible for re-election.

IV.—COUNCIL.

The Officers, together with the Premier and Leader of the Opposition for the time being, and eight others to be chosen annually from among the members, shall constitute a Council, by whom
