**LARGE BUILDING
FOR COLLEGE ST.**

Art Tailoring Company Will
Put Up Five-Storey Struc-
ture at Southwest Corner
of Markham.

A five-story structure, to cover the entire plot at the southwest corner of College-street and Bathurst-street, is planned by the Art Tailoring Co., which has bought the property from the St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church, for close to \$25,000. The land has a frontage on College-street of 116 feet, of which 55 feet is occupied by the church building, and 113 feet on Markham-street. The congregation is given a year to find a new site for their church.

The factory building will be occupied entirely by the tailoring company, except for the corner, which may be leased to a bank. Plans for the structure are not yet prepared, nor is the price put out of which it will be built. The decision will probably be made by the board and cost in the neighborhood of \$100,000.

The tailoring company now occupies leased premises at 476 Bathurst-street.

CHEESE MARKETS

CAMPBELLFORD, May 28.—Some 800 boxes of cheese were sold, totaling \$600 at 13 11-16c; balance refused at 12 1/2c.
