

The Words "Or Fund," in Clause 75, Said to be Very Significant-Suggestion that the Dominion Lands Act May be Amend ed Later-The Liberals Are Still Annihtlating Time.

hilating Time. Ottawa, Feb 13.—Although the Re-medial Bill may not reach its second reading for two weeks yet, mem-bers are vigorously discussing its pro-visions. Not unnaturally in a body of over 200 men, there must be wide di-vergencies of opinion, which will be manifested more strikingly when the debate on the second reading com-mences. The Liberals affect to laugh at the measure and say it is weak and vapid, that it means nothing. They point specially to the clauses 'soverning the financial aid to Catholic schools, but these clauses mean more than is apparent on the surface. Clause 75 is other things, the following : "No school district shall be deemed to be entitled to receive money from any legislative grant or fund in re-spect of any school which is not effi-cient." The words "or fund " are very sig-

cient." The words "or fund" are very sig-nificant. Clearly they imply some other source of financial assistance than that given by the Legislature, and your correspondent is in a position to state what this is. If the Manitoba Legisla-ture fails to do its duty towards the Catholic minority then it is not at all unilkely that the Dominion Lands Act will be amended next year by provid-ing that Catholics shall be entitled to a share in scholo lands of Manitoba-
