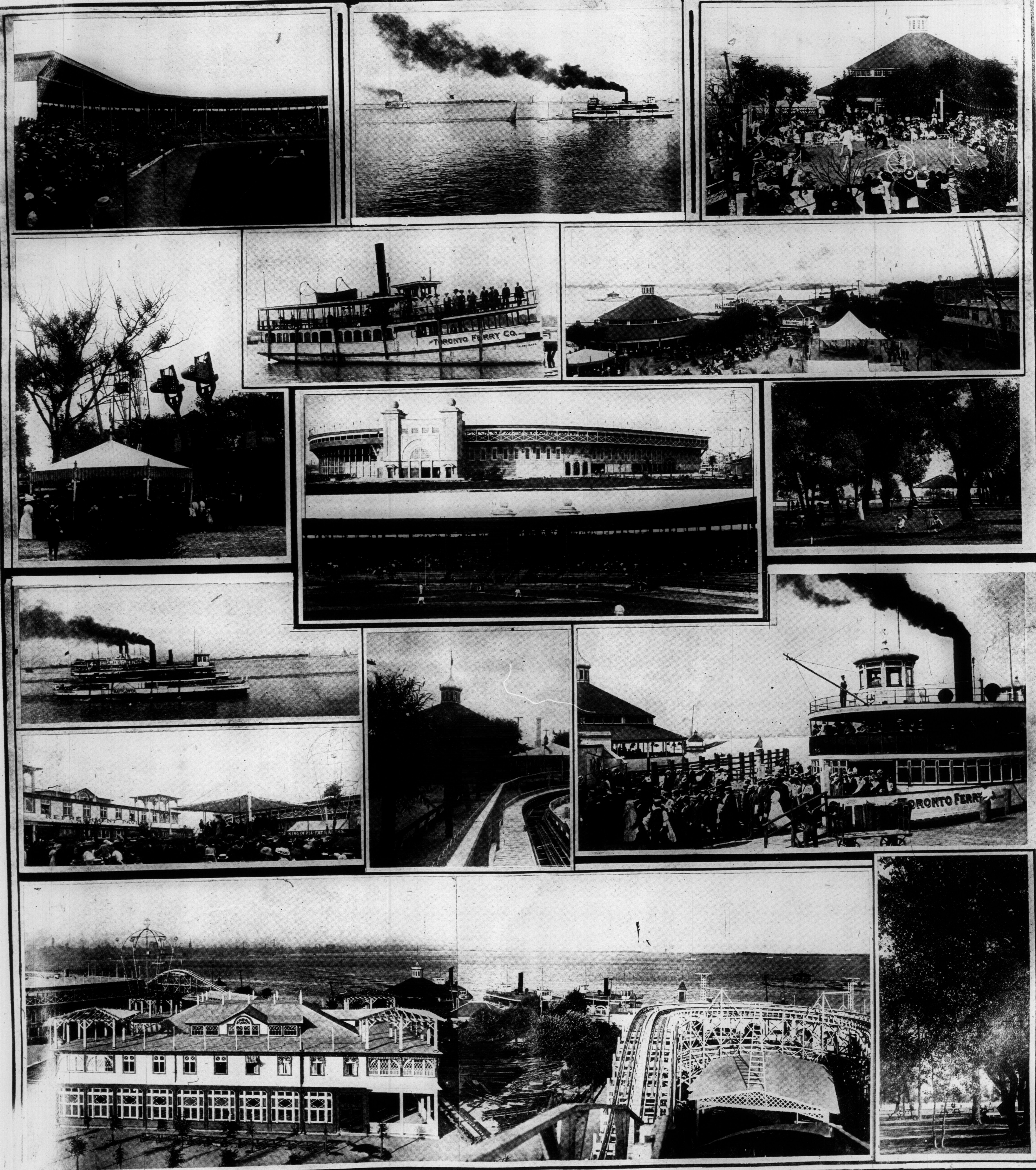


Snapshots of Hanlan's Point--Toronto's Coney Island
