**REACTION THROUGHOUT
THE WHOLE MINING LIST**

Has the Boom Culminated? — Indifferent Reception Now

(New York Journal of Commerce, Tuesday.)

The dominant theme of discussion in the stock market yesterday was the Nipissing crash, more attention being paid to curb quotations than to those on the stock exchange. **SAYS WATER
IS NOT PURE**

A Resident Suggests That St. John's Drinking Water Should be Analyzed Periodically and Results Published.

There is one prominent citizen who is very pronounced in his opinion of the present condition of the city water supply. The gentleman in question has traveled extensively, and among the places he has visited in the west is the city of Winnipeg, whose people are today, and have been for some time, confronted with the great problem of the water supply.

Speaking to the Times of the water supply in that city, he explained thoroughly the location of Winnipeg, which, he said, is perfectly level, and which, on account of its imperfect water supply, is today noted for the number of cases of typhoid fever that exist there.

Being perfectly level, it is impossible to get water forced up to the upper stories of high buildings in Winnipeg. As a result, the sanitary conditions are not by any means conducive to good health. The waste runs into the Red River, which, in question stated that a medical man had expressed the opinion to him that he was very doubtful as to the purity of the water which is present being consumed by citizens. He referred to the case brought by the city against Mrs. Sterling Barker, and said that although an injunction was granted by Mr. Justice Barker to restrain the proprietors of the Lockwood Hotel from allowing waste to run into the water which is used by the citizens, yet the common council is apparently at a standstill in the matter, and city residents are drinking water which is contaminated.

An important suggestion was made by the Times informant, and it was that an analyst expert should be appointed and paid a substantial salary by the provincial government to analyze the water weekly or fortnightly that is consumed by people throughout the province, and that each report should be published for the benefit of the citizens. In this way, the people would know the kind of water they were drinking, and would be better safeguarded in the line of public health than they are at present.

In connection with the appointment of a provincial analyst, reference was made to the great canal which the Japanese are now digging and sending them to their army. It is a well-known fact that they have analysts who analyze the water in the canal, and if they find the water impure the soldiers are not allowed to drink it, as the Japanese consider that the question of drinking pure water is of paramount importance.

It is understood that the Times informant will take a few samples of the city water and send them to the Dominion analyst to be analyzed, and the result of the analysis will be published.
