AUTHOR WHOSE BOOK FORETOLD DISASTER TO THE TITANIC IS DEAD

Morgan Robertson, inventor of the periscope, the "eye" of the dread submarine, author and poet, died suddenly standing up in Atlantic City, N. J., where he had gone for his health. The discovery of his death was as tragic as some of his tales of fiction, which included "Titanic," written in 1898, and depicting the sinking in mid-ocean through collision with an iceberg of a modern queen of the seas. The story was actually duplicated by the Titanic's disaster in
