MOTOR THIEVES

WILL BE SPANKED.

Judge Costworth Thinks Punishment Will Have Deterrent Effect.

(Toronto Mail and Empire.)

Satisfied that the spankings he has prescribed pretty frequently of late are being administered with good effect, Judge Costworth in the sessions yesterday marked two other young auto thieves for the "strap." Louis Gentile, who stole two autos, and several times, was sentenced to eighteen months at the jail farm and to three spankings of five slaps each. The lad had previously served one year for a similar offense. Samuel Gerbassie, associated with Gentile on one of the charge sheets, denied that he had anything to do with stealing S. J. Wells' auto. He accepted Gentile's offer to give him a "lift" home. Gerbassie was convicted under the "joy-riding" section of the act and paid a fine of \$100 for using an auto without authority. The two lads were caught in a lane with the car, but Gentile escaped, although two shots were fired after him. Gerald Shearer was sentenced to one year and a spanking for the theft of W. E. Corman's auto.
