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**STRIKE IN AINSWORTH CAMP.**  
Nelson, Jan. 7.—Another strike is reported on the Tiger property of the Ainsworth silver-lead camp, which is owned, and is being developed, by J. and P. Squires, of Ainsworth. The news was brought to Nelson by Sam Underhill, the well known miner. The Tiger claim is on Cedar creek, on the opposite side from and at the same elevation as, the Highland mine.
