trouble. Immediately raise the hand and gently open the lower lip, getting a little of the oil on it. You can lead him any where.

Give him a little of the extract on a piece of beet sugar or a potato.

Put eight drops of oil of sassafras into a lady's silver thimble.

Take the thimble between the lips, so that the oil may run down the tongue and mouth, and the thumb to prevent the oil from running out while you open the mouth of the horse.

As soon as you have opened the horse's mouth, lay the thimble over upon his tongue, and let your wrist go.

We will follow you like a pet dog.

He is now very playful, and will let you ride him, and may only be liable to bite.

Love him and he will love you. Feed him before you do yourself.

Shoo him well—groom him yourself in the cold, without shelter or covering; for the horse is a native of a warm climate, and in many respects his constitution is as tender as a man's.

If you want to dress him to lie down, stand him sideways, have a couple of leather straps ready, and when you are ready, tell him to lie down, and when you are ready, tell him to lie down, at the same time gently, firmly, and steadily pulling on a switch.
