And be it enacted, That at every such first school section meeting, the majority of the resident householders of such school 18 section present, shall elect one of their own number to preside over the proccedings of such meeting, and shall also appoint a Secretary 20 whose duty it shall be to record all the proceedings of such meeting; and the Chairman of such meeting shall decide all questions of 22 order subject to an appeal to the meeting, and shall give the casting vote in case of an equality of votes, and no other, and shall take the 24 votes in such manner as shall be desired by the majority of the electors present, and shall, at the request of any two electors, grant a poll for 20 recording the names of the voters by the Secretary: and it shall be the duty of the electors present at such meeting or a majority of them, 28 to elect from the householders resident in such section, three Trustees, who shall respectively continue in office as follows; the last person 30 elected shall continue in office until the next ensuing annual school meeting in such section, and until his successor is elected; the second 32 person elected, one year, and the first person elected, two years, from such next ensuing annual school meeting, and until their suc- 94 cessors are elected respectively : Provided always, that a correct copy of the proceedings of such first school section meeting, and 36 of every annual school section meeting, signed by the Chairman and Secretary, shall be forthwith transmitted by the Secretary to the $\mathbf{8 8}$ local Superintendent of Schools.

V1. And be it enacted, That at every annual school section 40 meeting in any Tornship as authorised and required to be held by the second section of this Act, it shall be the duty of the resident 42 householders of such section, present at such meeting, or a majority of them, -

Firstly. To elect a Cbairman and Secretary who shall perform the duties required of the Chairman and Secretary by the fifth 46 section of this Act.

Secondly. To receive and decide upon the report of the Trustees, 48 as authorized and provided for by the eighteenth clause of the twelith section of this Act.
