Tarmer, residing in the Township of Blenheim, and District of London, Oro. : vince of Upper Canada aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, That the said William Hennedy Smith for and in consideration of the sum of one Hundred and Twenty five founds Gurreney, of Upper Canada to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged, and also in the further con: sideration, of the yearly Rent herein after mentioned, and agreed to by the said parties to be paid, observed and performed by the said Moses Kitchen, Hath Granted, Demised, Leased, Let, and to Farm Letten unto the said Moses Kitchen his heirs, Executors, Admis mistrators and Assigns, and by these presents Doch Grant, Demise, Lease, Let, and to Jarm Letten, unto the said Moses Hitchen his heirs, Executors, Administrators or Assigns All That pancel or Fract of Land situated in the said County of Wentworth, and District aforesaid, Being part of a Fract of Land Franted De. mised and Leased unto the said William Kenne 9 : dy Smith, by the late Captain Soseph Brant duly appointed Agent, and Wrincipal Chief of the Sia Nation Indians residing on the Grand River called the Ouse, bearing date the Twen tieth day of June, one Thousand Leven Hundred and Ninety Six, and containing Twelve Hundred acres or thereby, being for the full end, and Term of Nine Hundred and Ninety Nine years from the afresaid date Which warcel of Land her
