This Indenture made the ^{1st} day of April of the year one Thousand Eight Hundred, and Twenty Eight, Between William Kennedy Smith Farmer, residing on the Grand River Territory in the County of Wentworth, and District of Gore, Province of Upper Canada of the one part, and Moses Hitchen. Farmer, residing in the Township of Blenheim, and District of London, Province of Upper Canada aforesaid of the other part; Witnesseth, That the said William Kennedy Smith for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty five Pounds Currency, of Upper Canada to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and also in the further consideration, of the yearly Rent herein after mentioned, and agreed to by the said parties to be paid, observed and performed by the said Moses Hitchen, Hath Granted, Demised, Leased, Let, and to Farm Letten unto the said Moses Hitchen his heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, and by these presents Doth Grant, Demise, Lease, Let, and to Farm Letten, unto the said Moses Hitchen his heirs, Executors, Administrators or Assigns All That parcel or Tract of Land situated in the said County of Wentworth, and District aforesaid, Being part of a Tract of Land Granted Demised and Leased unto the said William Kennedy Smith, by the late Captain Joseph Brant duly appointed Agent, and principal Chief of the Six Nation Indians residing on the Grand River called the Cuse, bearing date the Twentieth day of June, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Six, and containing Twelve Hundred acres or thereby, being for the full end, and Term of Nine Hundred and Ninety Nine years from the aforesaid date, Which parcel of Land hereby Let do
