Sir,

With reference to the remarks in your letter of 15th inst. respecting the amount still due by Mr. R. S. Appleby for land on lots 4.5.7.8.9. in I.S.R. Tiendniaga, I have to say that your memo. of the amounts paid by Mr. Appleby does not agree with the entries in the Books of this Office, which have (with one exception) been verified by an examination of the Progress Returns, in which the entries in question appeared.
