---WITNESS: I further produce M.F.B. 1481 being a Certificate of transportation in the amount of \$16.50 signed by Lieutenant D.A. Raymond officer issuing transport warrants.

Q- ---PROSECUTOR: To whom does that document refer ?

A- ---WITNESS: To the accused, sir.
