timber or pulp licenses, with the exception of Nos. 7 and 10.

THE CHAIRMAN: I understand, then, that with the exception of Nos. 7 and 10 they are all clear. I think you had better put that letter in just as it is. Exhibits C15 (letter from Deputy Minister of Lands) C14. (List of new locations asked for) and C.15 (Map with the locations applied for marked) were then put in.

IR TYSON: - Now these applications I have classified, on the different Islands. On Swindle Island, Nos. 6 and 7: Princess Royal

Island Nos. 9,10,11,12,15,5 and 4; Aristanable Inland, Nos. 1,2 and

3; Price's Island, No. 8. These are the location numbers as marked on the blue-print.

THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think we had a list of those applications before did we? You simply made a statement to us yesterday?

A. Yes, that is so.

MR COMMISSIONER SHAW: They are all open with the exception of Nos. 7 and 10?

- A. Yes, all except Nos. 7 and 10.
- Q. Has the Department of Lands ever been notified that these lands were being applied for?
 - A. I don't know.

MR COMMISSIONER McKENNA: No doubt the Deputy Minister of Lands has had them marked on his own maps over at the Lands Department so that he will be able to identify them?

A. Yes.
