Throw all men by these presents that we she principal village and Star Chiefs of the setawa, Ohippawa, Tatawatany and Savon Sudian Nations of Detroit for and in considerates of the sum of Twelve hundred prinds Currency of the Townce of Quebec at Tive shillings per Spanish Dollar for valuable stones and elerchandinge loves delivered by the hands of Hexander M. 15ee Esquire Coputy agant of Indian affairs the recept where of we do hereby acknowledge, have by and with the consent of the whole of our said nations, given, granted enferfled abendted and confirmed, and by these presents do sure want enferth aher and conform unto his estagesty George the Third Stone of Great Britain Trance and Ireland Defender of the Faith gea sea sea a certain Track of Land beginning at the mouth of Carlish Creeks commanly called Buin an Chandiere in the month side of Latie Ene being the Western extranity of a Tract prorchased by his said Myesty from the essesses again Indians in the year me Thousand seven hundred and eighty I now and from stonce mening stestward along the barder of Latte line and up the Sheight to the month of a Buin known by the name of Channail icarte and up the main branch of the said Channel Ecarte to the first forth on the South side then a due East time untitl it intersects the Bir a La Franche and up the said Bur in La Tranche to the mouth west Corner of the said Cession granted to his estaiesty in the year one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty Jour, then following the Western boundary of said Tract being a due South direction untill it shittes the mouth of , Segmed, I Smith C. C. P
