

XIII.

No member shall be allowed to vote on any question who is not within the bar at the time when such question is put by the President, except by leave of the Conference, when such member has been necessarily absent.

XIV.

Every member who shall be within the bar at the time the question is put shall give his vote, unless the Conference, for special reasons, excuse him.

XV.

No resolution altering, rescinding, or proposing any new rule of discipline, shall be adopted, until it shall have been at least one day in the possession of the Conference.

XVI.

A motion to adjourn shall always be in order, and shall be decided without debate.
