# Stock Exchange Notes

Montreal, December 1, 1910.

The market of the past week has been devoid of any special interest and the general tendency was heavy with prices sagging to a lower level. Quebec Railway continued fairly prominent, in comparison with the trading in other stocks but the feverish stage in the stock seems to have passed, with no serious damage except sentimentally. Episodes such as these are regrettable and tend to reflect on the methods of trading in general. "Soo" Common and Canadian Pacific are both lower on small trading. Dominion Steel Corporation and Quebec Railway were the active stocks and the only ones in which the trading involved over 2.000 shares. Cement Common, Montreal Power and Rio Power were next in point of volume of business and all figured prominently. Dominion Iron Bonds appeared to the extent of \$11,000. Crown Reserve was a small factor and closes lower than a week ago. The markets in New York have been heavy during the past few days. The Bank of England rate was changed to 4 1-2 per cent.
