SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST Homestead Regulations. ANY even numbered section of Dominion lands in Manitoba or the Northwest Provinces, excepting 8 and 36, not reserved, may be homesteaded upon by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 100 acres, more or less.
