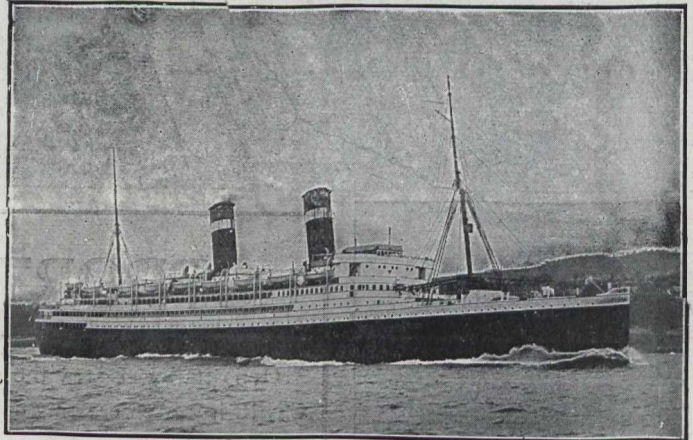


# ALLAN ROYAL MAIL LINE TO CANADA.
