years, with or without hard labour, and with or without solitary confinement; and the wilful alteration for any purpose of fraud of deceit, of any such document or thing or of any document of thing the forging of which is made penal by this Act, shall be held to be a forging thereof.

As to other matters.

Forging any instrument, however designated, which is in law a will, bill of exchange, &c.

46. Where by this or any other Act any person is or shall hereafter be made liable to punishment for forging or altering, of for offering, uttering, disposing of, or putting off, knowing same to be forged or altered, any instrument or writing designated in such Act by any special name or description, and such instru ment or writing, however designated, is in law a will, testament codicil or testamentary writing, or a deed, bond or writing obligation tory, or a bill of exchange, or a promissory note for the payment of money, or an indorsement on, or assignment of a bill of ex change, or promissory note for the payment of money, or acceptance of a bill of exchange, or an undertaking, warrant order, authority, or request for the payment of money, or indorsement on or assignment of an undertaking, warrant, order authority, or request for the payment of money, within the true intent and meaning of this Act, in every such case the person forging or altering such instrument or writing, or offering, utter ing, disposing of, or putting off such instrument or writing, know ing the same to be forged or altered, may be indicted as offender against this Act, and punished accordingly.

Forging, &c., in Canada, documents purporting to be made, or actually made payable out of Vanada.

47. Where the forging or altering any writing or matter what soever, or the offering, uttering, disposing of, or putting off writing or matter whatsoever, knowing the same to be forged altered, is in this Act expressed to be an offence, if any person out of Canada, Canada forges, or alters, or offers, utters, disposes of, or puts or forging, &c. knowing the same to be forged or altered, any such writing in Canada, bills, &c., pur matter, in whatsoever country or place out of Canada, whether porting to be under the dominion of Hon Marian under the dominion of Her Majesty or not, such writing or meting may purport to be made or may have been made, and in what ever language the same or any part thereof may be expressed every such person, and every person aiding, abetting, or colling such person shall be described aiding, abetting, or colling such person shall be described aiding. selling such person, shall be deemed to be an offender within meaning of this Act, and shall be punishable thereby in the manner as if the writing or matter had purported to be made had been made in Canada; and if any person in Canada forget, or alters, or offers, utters, disposes of, or puts off, knowing are to be forced or alters. same to be forged or altered, any bill of exchange, or any promise sory note for the payment of money, or any indorsement of assignment of any bill of exchange or promissory note for payment of money, or any acceptance of any bill of exchange any undertaking, warrant, order, authority, or request for payment of money, or for the delivery or transfer of any goods and security or any dead have been delivery or transfer of any goods and of money, (whether such deed, bond, or writing obligatory is many
