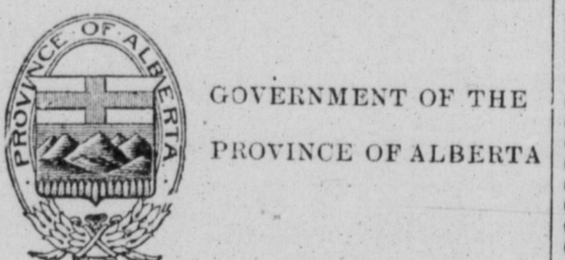

Educational Tax Act, Village Act, and the School Assessment Ordinance
