Any person who is the sole head of tamily, or any mais over 18 years old, continuance during the winter may homestead a quarter section of svaliable Dominion land in Manitoba, thousands of transit svaliable Dominion land in manual parts cant must appear in person at the Doand district. Entry by proxy may e mather by lather, mather, e.n. anghier, brother or sister of intending conditions by lather. mather, e.n. stender. schedule 8.15 a. m. daily and the Bottes-Six months' residence, upon and calification of its hand in each of three years. A homesteador may live within size miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solaly owned and occupied by 4 m or by his father, mother, pan, daughter, mother or sigexcept Saturday. In certain districts a homesteeder in good standing may pre-supi a quarter section slongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre

Duties-Must reside upon the hon tead or pre-emplica six months in each of six years from data of home-stead entry (including the time required a homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has oxbauste is homestead right and cannot obtain a comption may enter for a purchas-add present in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre, Duties.-Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.


