land of mystery and certainly some of the things that are done by the wandering magicians of that country are almost beyond comprehension. These strange men are met with in all kinds of unexpected places and they assuredly do perform tricks that take a lot


basket trick. Most people have seen the mango tree trick, famous throughout the world. A small hole is made by the wonder worker in the ground with his fingers, and a mango seed is put into this hole and covered with mud Water is poured over it and then a basket placed over the top, covered

in turn by a cloth. After a while the cloth and the cover are removed partly in order to give the onlookers a glimpse of a plant which has grown to a height of about six inches. Later the plant is uncovered and is found to have grown to a foot in height with leaves and twigs, and at the last stage of uncovering the plant has reached a cubic and is bearing fresh fruit.

The basket trick is another favorite trick of the wandering Indian magician. With some difficulty a boy is placed into a basket in a doubled up attitude. The basket is then covered with a cloth, and the conjurer draws a long kitchen knife which he thrusts into the centre of the basket. Thereafter the knife is drawn out dripping with a red fluid resembling blood, but when the cloth is removed and the basket is upturned the boy is found to be no longer inside, but approaching the gathering of interestctators from the rear.
