His Majesty the King of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions

beyond the Seas, Emperor of India, and His Majesty the King of Sweden;
Being desirous to render mutual assistance in the conduct of legal proeedings, in their respective territories, in civil and commercial matters which are being dealt with or which may possibly be dealt with by their respective Judicial authorities;

Have resolved to conclude a Convention for this purpose and have

- High Contracting Party" shall be interpreted as meaning at any time any of the territories of such High Contracting Party to which the Convention at that time applies.

#### II.—Service of Judicial and Extra-Judicial Documents

#### ARTICLE 2

When judicial or extra-judicial documents drawn up in the territory of one of the High Contracting Parties are required to be served on persons, Partnerships, companies, Societies or other corporations in the territory of the other High Contracting Party, such documents may be served on the recipient, whatever his nationality, in the manner provided in Article 3.

### ARTICLE 3

- (a) A request for service shall be addressed by a Consular Officer of the high Contracting Party, from whose territory the documents to be served manate, to the competent authority of the country where the documents are be served, requesting such authority to cause the documents to be served. The request shall be sent by such Consular Officer to such authority.
- (b) The request for service shall be drawn up in the language of the Country where service is to be effected.
