

TABLE SCHEDULE 1

An Airline or airlines designated by the Government of Jamaica shall be entitled to operate the agreed services on each of the specified routes, in both directions, and to make scheduled landings in Canada at the points specified in this paragraph: provided that such services shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

1. From Jamaica to Montreal and Toronto.
2. From Jamaica via the Cayman Islands, the Bahamas Islands and Trinidad to Toronto.
3. From Jamaica via the Cayman Islands, the Bahamas Islands and New York to Montreal.

An Airline or airlines designated by the Government of Canada shall be entitled to operate the agreed services on each of the specified routes, in both directions, and to make scheduled landings in Jamaica at the points specified in this paragraph: provided that such services shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

From Canada via the Cayman Islands and the Bahamas Islands to Kingston and/or Montego Bay and beyond to Haiti, the Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, the Netherlands Antilles, Barbados, Trinidad and Tobago, and South America.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Schedule, the Government of Jamaica may, at the option of the designated airline, be served in any order or be omitted on any or all flights, provided that in all cases flights arrive at least one point in the country designating the airline.
