On May 26, 1973, Brian Mulroney married Mila Pivnicki, a Yugoslav-born engineering student and the daughter of prominent Montreal psychiatrist, Dr. Dimitrije Pivnicki and his wife Bogdanka.

The Mulroneys have three children: Caroline, born on June 11, 1974; Ben, born on March 9, 1976; and Mark, born on April 29, 1979. Like their mother, the Mulroney children are trilingual, speaking English, French and Serbo-Croatian.
