populations seeking better economic opportunities has created serious international problems. Drugs are an increasing problem in developed and developing countries. Terrorism is a threat to innocent people around the world. Human rights violations remain a blight on humanity, especially when institutionalized as in South Africa.

Today's changing world thus presents possibilities and challenges. Canada is committed to a global, activist foreign policy, both bilaterally and multilaterally in the U.N., the Economic, Commonwealth, and Francophone summits and other organizations and fora. The United States will be a key dialogue partner in this process.
