The returning officer shall publish in each district notice of the election, containing a list of candidates and the names of the electors who are entitled to vote at the election. A war service elector who is unable to vote at the election may have the returning officer read his vote for him in the presence of another elector chosen by himself.

Resident electors, and those who are not resident electors, shall be entitled to vote at the election, and the returning officer shall be responsible for ensuring that each elector is able to vote at the election.
