

vii) Broaden the base of Canadian researchers working with France by pro-actively encouraging partnership activities.

viii) Take advantage of the annual visits of S&T counsellors and Technology Development Officers (TDOs) to Canada to have them meet with as many Canadian companies as possible, including small and medium businesses, that might be interested in key French technologies.
